

Senior Farmers Market Vouchers Available

Rep. Karen Boback is reminding eligible senior citizens about this important program.



What is the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)?

The SFMNP provides four \$5 vouchers for participants to redeem at qualified farmers markets or roadside stands. The vouchers can be used toward fresh fruits, vegetables and herbs. Baked goods, cider, honey, jam and meats are not included in the program. Seniors are eligible for one set of four vouchers per year.

Vouchers are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Who does the program benefit?

Residents of Luzerne or Wyoming counties (proof of residency required) who will be at least 60 or turn 60 within the year (proof of age required) and who meet annual household income limits* as follows:

1 Person - \$22,459

2 People - \$30,451

3 People - \$38,443

4 People - \$46,435

**Income guidelines are subject to change and are based on federal guidelines in place on June 22.*
